

SETTING

The location and time of the story

MAIN CHARACTER

a person or animal who the story is mostly about

PROBLEM

the main challenge or difficulty the character is facing: the problem

SOLUTION

how the problem is solved; the resolution

POINT OF VIEW

the way in which the story is told

1st person: the character narrates the story (I, we, me)

2nd Person: Author speaks to reader (you, your)

3rd person: author tells a story (he, she, they)

THEME

the message or lesson of the story

PLOT

the main events in the order they happened in the story

MINOR CHARACTER

a person or animal who is not very important to the
story
